Knowledge of Historical Context	barely indicates any previous historical knowledge	limited use of previous historical knowledge without complete accuracy	uses previous general historical knowledge to examine issues included in the source	shows evidence of thorough knowledge of period in which source was created; relates source to historical context in which it was created	
Identification of Key Issues/Main Points	deals only briefly and vaguely with the key issues and main points in the source	describes in general terms one issue or concept included in the source	identifies most but not all of the key issues and main points in the source	identifies the key
