- A Within these lines, one or two well sized and convenient tenements might be formed. - The greater part of the land is capable of high improvement for meadow; being low; part of it is already reclaimed - and part still to reclaim - requiring to be drained. - There are no houses on it. -
- B Great part within these lines is in wood, but there is a sufficiency of ground cleared and in cultivation, for a middle sized farm, with a house on it; and a most beautiful site for a Gentlemans seat. -
- C Is the same, and the whole is cleared land, but has no house on it
- D Is also cleared land, and might be added to River farm; - or, if that farm should be sub-divided, it might form part of the smaller ones. - affording pleasant sites for houses on the banks of the River.
- E The use of this farm is altered to a relation
